TECHNICAL NOTES

Family Tree Personal pages

1. One of the most frequent questions participants have is "Can you help me get to my personal page at Family Tree? I lost my information in a computer crash (forgot my password, etc). So here's the "quick and dirty" on this.

I don't have your passwords for Family Tree's personal pages. So, look at the top of their home page for the LOGIN area. Put in your kit number and then just to the right of the Password you should see a link that says "Forgotten your password?" Click on that. You should get an email and then you follow the directions. If, for some reason, that doesn't work, email Ashley Coursey at Family Tree DNA ashley@familytreedna.com for help accessing your personal page.

2. Please enter your oldest known ancestor, year of birth and location (as much detail as possible) on the USER PREFERENCES pages (scroll down to the bottom) and the GPS for that location. Please remember that just because you know that Dipintheroad Texas in Bigbad County, not everyone who looks at your record will. I especially ask for those with English locations to be specific – Bursley, England doesn't tell us if Bursley is a Parish, a town, a county, a region within a county, an "old" county or what. As to GPS get as close as you can. If you only know the state, use the state capital, if you only know the county, use the county seat. For a farm, use the nearest town.

- a. Your maternal ancestor is NOT your oldest known WEBB ancestor's wife. This is for the mtDNA lineages. If you have not tested mtDNA this should be BLANK. mtDNA lineage is your mother's mother's mother's mother's mother....etc.. Your maternal ancestor is NOT
